DRIVER EDUCATION REGISTRATION

Dear Parents:

Your son/daughter has expressed an interest in the Driver Education program to be offered at Thom Collegiate High School.

This course will consist of a minimum of 30 hours classroom and six hours behind-the-wheel incar instruction, and will be conducted under the direction of Saskatchewan Learning.

The object of Driver Education is to prepare competent and skillful young drivers. It is most important, therefore, that the student be allowed to practice in the family car until he/she has mastered what has been taught. It is in this area that parents have a great part to play in the satisfactory completion of the training.

Your attention is drawn to the fact that students in this program will hold a Class 7 learner's license.

Please note the following restrictions:

- Must have a supervising driver in the front passenger seat at all hours
- Supervising driver must be an experienced, licensed driver (not in the G.D.L. Program)
- Between midnight and 5:00AM passengers must be immediate family members
- Number of passengers limited to number of seat belts
- Cannot consume any alcohol and drive (zero blood alcohol content)

Effective September 1, 2005, Saskatchewan's new Graduated Driver's Licensing Program (G.D.L.) replaced the Probationary Driver's program.

The only cost to the student will be the usual cost of a license.

High School Driver Education New Computerized Testing

SGI is changing the way you complete your Class 7 learner's exam in high school driver education. It can now be done on a computer! To make this happen, you will need to visit a licence issuer with identification before the day of your test to obtain an SGI Customer Number. A Customer Number and e-mail address is required to activate your My SGI account. This can be done well in advance – the sooner the better!

STEP 1: Obtain An SGI Customer Number

You can do this by visiting your local motor licence issuer or any SGI motor vehicle branch office.

- You will need a minimum of two pieces of original identification to establish your full legal name, complete date of birth and signature (e.g. Canadian Birth certificate/Canadian Passport, and Saskatchewan Health Card)
- Don't forget to provide an e-mail address which is needed in Step 2
- You will be given a Personal Identification Document. Please verify all information on this document to ensure it is complete and accurate (i.e. height, gender, eye color). Do Not Lose This! You will be required to provide this to your driving instructor.

If you have SGI photo ID, you *already* have an SGI Customer Number and will only need to ensure you have an e-mail address on file with SGI. An e-mail address is required to activate your MySGI account. To add this information, you may call or visit your local motor licence issuer or call the SGI Customer Service Centre in Regina (306) 775-6900 or toll free 1-800-667-9868.

STEP 2: Register for MySGI

- Make sure you have added an e-mail address to your customer profile. An activation code will automatically be sent to your e-mail account. You will use this code to set up your MySGI account
- Register for a secure, on-line account by going to www.sgi.sk.ca/online * and select the Register button
- Select I have an activation code
- Select Submit
- Enter your customer number and your activation code; then select the **Submit** button
- Create a username and password and submit
- Review and accept the Terms of Use**
- Welcome to MySGI!!

At the time of your learner's exam, you will be required to log into your MySGI account with your username and password. From there, you will access the testing application. Features of computerized testing include: colored graphics clarifying each question, immediate feedback after each answered question (correct or incorrect), and immediate scoring (pass or fail).

- * Not mobile browser compatible at this time.
- ** You will be required to search and select a motor licence issuer of your choice. We recommend searching by city or postal code.
