CAP & GOWN CEREMONY 2022

(The Cap & Gown Ceremony is the formal academic part of Graduation)

Date:	Monday, June 27, 2022		
Location:	<b>Conexus Arts Centre</b> Lakeshore Drive, Regina, SK		
Time:	Program begins at 9:00 a.m. and will last approximately two hours. Doors open at 8:30 a.m. * <i>Students need to meet at 7:30 a.m. (see details below)</i>		
Eligibility:	Only those students who achieve the required 24 credits as prescribed by the Ministry of Education will be permitted to walk across the stage to receive their diplomas and have their names printed in the program.		
	Students must not have any outstanding fees, books or accounts of any kind. Please pay any outstanding accounts prior to June 17 <sup>th</sup> .		
Cost:	<b>\$60.00 per student</b> – This fee pays for hall rental, the purchase of graduation gown, and the purchase of the graduation cap, which is theirs to keep. Only those students who will achieve a complete Grade 12 standing are allowed to participate in this ceremony.		
Gown Pick-up:	Caps and Gowns can be picked up on the last day of exams, Friday June 21 <sup>st</sup> between 9:30 and 12:00pm in Room 105. Please keep them clean and <b>don't forget to bring them with you to the ceremony</b> . They are yours to keep!		
Ceremony:	On Graduation Day at Conexus Arts Centre, Grade 12 students will meet downstairs in the Schumiatcher Room at <b>7:30</b> a.m. where they will participate in a rehearsal. Graduates will begin lining up for the Processional at 8:30 a.m. Guests are asked to be seated by 8:45 a.m. The ceremony will begin at 9:00 sharp.		
	At this ceremony, students will receive their diplomas and any academic awards that they have earned during the course of the year. Students will be on stage long enough for parents to photograph the proud moment. The front row will be reserved for this purpose.		
Dress Code:	Gentlemen: dress pants; no shorts; no sandals or flip flops. Ladies: dress pants; skirts, dresses, dress sandals or shoes; no flip flops.		
Pictures:	When the ceremony is complete, grads are free to take photographs with family and friends.
