

Regina District Industry Education Council (RDIEC) represents Regina Public School Division, Regina Catholic School Division, Prairie Valley School Division and File Hills Qu'Appelle Tribal Council. The RDIEC organizes Career Spotlights which provide an opportunity for interested Grade 10-12's to obtain information about specific career opportunities. SOLDIER FOR A DAY is a program designed to give students the opportunity to learn more about military training and career opportunities in the Canadian Forces Army Reserve. Emphasis is placed on building confidence, teamwork, and self-discipline. Soldier for a Day will take place at the *Regina Armoury* -*1600 Elphinstone St. Tuesday March 31, 2020 from 9:30AM to 2:30PM*

During the event, applicants will receive training in weapon's handling, drill and the understanding of trades training that is offered by the Canadian Military. They will also receive a comprehensive overview of the various functions and capabilities of our military at home and abroad. Due to Canadian Forces regulations, **participants will NOT be firing weapons or driving military vehicles** however, there will be considerable hands on experiences. Safety is of paramount importance in all stages of the program. Applicants are closely supervised at all times.

Soldier for a Day is a fast paced and knowledge intensive program. ALL applicants must be prepared both mentally and physically to participate in various lessons, exercises, and training throughout the day. ALL applicants selected to participate in the program are expected to demonstrate maximum interest, participation, and effort. Applicants should wear appropriate shoes and clothing that allow for comfort and movement. If the student is under the age of 18, the applicant must discuss their intent to apply with their PARENTS or GUARDIANS. All minors MUST have parental consent in order to participate in the program and a parent or guardian will be required to co-sign the waiver.

The school will allow students to attend and their absence will be excused but students are responsible for all material missed in class that day. RELEASE OF LIABILITY

WAIVER OF CLAIMS, ASSUMPTION OF RISKS AND INDEMNISATION AGREEMENT

I, _____, realizing the inherent risks and the potential dangers of participating in the use of Canadian Forces weapons, on behalf of myself, my heirs, devisees, successors, assigns, executors, and administrators, in consideration of being permitted to participate in the use of Canadian Forces weapons do hereby:

- a. **Waive all claims** of any nature or kind whether in contract, tort, negligence or otherwise, against Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada, Her officers, servants, agents, employees and members of Her Canadian Forces, all in their employment and private capacities, in a manner arising out of, based upon, occasioned by or attributable to the activities of them, including the **NEGLIGENCE** on their part, or any action taken or things done or maintained by virtue thereof;
- b. **Having** determined that the activities are inherently hazardous and may result in physical harm and wishing in any event to carry out the activity, voluntarily assume any risks that may be associated with the activity;
- c. At all times indemnify and save harmless Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada, Her officers, servants, agents, employees and members of Her Canadian Forces from and against all claims and demands, loss, costs, damages, actions, causes of action, suits or other proceedings by whomsoever made, brought, or prosecuted in manner, related to any loss, property damage, personal injury or death, resulting from, occasioned by or attributable in any way to my use of Canadian Forces weapons;
- d. **Covenant that I** will not commence or maintain against any person, any action or proceeding which will give rise to a claim against Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada, Her officers, servants, agents, employees and members of Her Canadian Forces for contribution or indemnity; and
- e. **Acknowledge having** read this Waiver of Claims. Assumption of Risks and Indemnification Agreement and understanding the Agreement is intended to be broad and all inclusive so as to preclude any claims, indicate my acceptance of this document by my signature.
