# City of Regina Mandatory Masking Requirements Will Apply to All Regina Exhibition Association Limited Facilities

**Regina, Saskatchewan** – As a City of Regina (City) owned facility, Regina Exhibition Association Limited (REAL) will comply with the requirement that everyone must wear a mask when visiting indoor city facilities. As announced by the City, the mandatory masking requirement takes effect on Saturday, September 4.

This requirement applies to all indoor facilities on the REAL Campus including the Queensbury Convention Centre, AffinityPlex, International Trade Centre, Brandt Centre, Cooperators Centre and the Canada Centre Complex.

Masks will also be required when visiting any of the indoor portions of Mosaic Stadium including any indoor lobby, lounge, suite, operational areas, elevators or washroom facilities.

Children under 2 years of age, persons with medical conditions, or those who cannot place or remove masks without assistance are exempt.

If you are attending an event on the REAL Campus where food and beverages are being served, such as a wedding, you must wear a mask unless you are eating or drinking. Masks are not required during physical activity but must be worn in public spaces.

REAL is a GBAC-STAR certified facility which means the organization has implemented the most stringent protocols for cleaning, disinfection and infectious disease prevention within all of its campus facilities.
